Sancerre, <u>Sauvignon Blanc</u>, Michel Girault, Loire Valley, 2021 <i>Pale gold with green hints. The entry is soft and round. It ends with a clean lingering finish.</i>	16 74
Chablis, <u>Chardonnay</u>, Domaine William Fèvre, Burgundy, 2020 <i>Fresh and supple, the wine is marked by mineral notes that are typical of the appellation.</i> <i>93 Points by James Suckling</i>	18 77
Meursault "Les Clous", <u>Chardonnay</u>, Bouchard Père & Fils, Burgundy, 2019 <i>8 to 10 months in French oak. Intense bouquet of fruit and flowers. With a delicate mineral hint.</i> <i>93 Points by James Suckling</i>	28 136
Châteauneuf-du-Pape Blanc, <u>Grenache Blanc/Clairette/Roussanne</u>, Clos Saint Jean, Southern Rhône, 2021 <i>Lush, with a honeyed edge to the mix of pear. While a light thread of acacia adds nuance.</i>	29 138
Condrieu "La Petite Côte", <u>Viognier</u>, Yves Cuilleron, Northern Rhône, 2020 <i>Ripe and juicy, with a mix of apricot, nectarine, melon and pear flavors.</i> <i>Reveals an anise hint through the finish.</i>	31 145

- Brunello di Montalcino DOCG, Sangiovese, Il Poggione** 28 136
Tuscany Italy, 2017
Aromas of ripe blackberries and dark cherries which come together with toast, spices, hazelnut with hints of spring floral and leather.

- Pommard, Pinot Noir, Bouchard Père & Fils, Burgundy, 2019** 28 136
A dense, chunky style, this evokes cherry, strawberry, earth and iron flavors. Tightens up on the compact finish, with a crisp, almost citrusy feel.

- Châteauneuf-du-Pape Rouge, Grenache-Syrah, Clos Saint Jean,** 29 138
Southern Rhône, 2019
This has a dark tea frame around lightly steeped cherry and raspberry fruit notes. Light garrigue and humus hints underscore the finish.

- Saint-Emilion, Merlot-Cabernet Franc-Cabernet Sauvignon,** 34 164
Château Fugères Grand Cru Classe, Bordeaux, 2018
Beautiful aromas and flavors of warm fig and boysenberry. The finish ripples with fruit and fresh acidity.

- Saint Julien, Cabernet Sauvignon-Merlot-Cabernet Franc-Petit Verdot,** 38 192
Château Gloria Domaines Martin, Bordeaux, 2016
This wine has a slight chunky feel to it, with bramble and tar notes jutting out, but the core is saturated with cassis and blackberry fruit flavors. Offers a lovely tug of sweet tobacco on the finish.
